Zoofari Parks Conservation Grants Guidelines

Zoofari Parks and its living museums, Virginia Safari Park, Gulf Breeze Zoo, Alabama Safari Park and Texas Zoofari Park, are dedicated to supporting conservation through public education, cooperative breeding programs, and support of habitat preservation and in situ projects worldwide.

Zoofari Parks is privately owned and does not receive any state or federal tax support. Our conservation programs are funded through the support of our park visitors. Zoofari Parks is truly "Where Conservation Meets Adventure" and as such dedicates a percentage of every educational encounter to conservation.

Submission guidelines

- Applications for 2023 grants will be accepted through May 31, 2023
- Grants requests may range from \$500 to \$5,000
 - Decisions will be made by December 31, 2023, and funding available by January 15, 2024
- Preference will be given to projects that impact fauna and habitats in Texas, Virginia, Alabama, Florida, or locations within the United States
 - Applications for international programs may be considered.
- Project eligibility: Specific conservation and research measures that directly contribute to the survival of a species, preferably in its natural range, or habitat preservation/reforestation. Ex situ research and/or rescue that has a direct implication for the conservation of in situ species may be considered.
- The principal researcher must be associated with a recognized institution (zoo, academic institution, conservation or non-profit organization).
- Only electronic submissions will be accepted.
- Only complete applications will be considered.

2. Only complete applications will be considered.
3. Applications should be no more than five pages, excluding appendices.

By signing below, the applicant agrees to the following:

- The principal researcher is associated with a recognized institution (zoo, academic institution, conservation or non-profit organization).
- The project will submit a progress report within six months of receiving the grant. (Photos illustrating the project are appreciated)
- The project will submit an annual or final report within one year after the grant period ends, including an accounting for the grant funds provided by Zoofari Parks.

- If the project does not commence within one year of receipt of the grant, the funds will be returned upon request by Zoofari Parks
- The project agrees that their reports (annual reports, status reports, any other documents, photos, multimedia, etc) can be used unrestricted by Zoofari Parks and its parks for publication, website, social media, and other media.
- The project will acknowledge Zoofari Park's (and its parks) support in any publications, public media, and website presentation of the funded project.
